

## **REPORT**

## Bologna July 4, 2015

Good morning,

I would like to talk you about an important hearing that Unic@ had on 23 June in Rome at the Parliament, as part of the "DDL Competition" (the famous bill ...) in front of many members of Commissions Finance and production activities.

There were Gabriele Rossetti (Presidente), Dina Nicosia (Vice President), Maurizia Bertoncino (Secretary) e Giampaolo Bergo (Member).

The hearing has been requested by our President to draw the attention of the Government on the consequences of the "feared liberalization" which, inevitably, will have an impact also on the "staff of the notary" as an integral part of the system NOTARIAT and if the bill was approved that certainly, as well as create devastating effects in many areas (such as lower public protection, fewer guarantees, debasement of the public function that characterizes for many years the figure of Notary), and would cause a severe employment crisis.

President Gabriel Rossetti, in particular, showed that already the previous liberalizations had a negative impact on the "occupiers in the sector" which, since 2006 have been reduced drastically, inevitably involving thousands of families.

Members of the Commission, appeared particularly sensitive and attentive to this issue and it was the first time that employees notary officially entered in the Italian Parliament.

We explained how the Notary Employees could be seriously damages if this bill will be approved so as to increase the number of notaries.

There would be drastic reduction of qualified and trained employees

who would not find easily place in the world of work and the professions in particular.

President Rossetti, reiterated also that employees work in a system based on guarantees and certainty and they absorbs ( we must not forget ..), about 30,000 / 35,000 work units.

We must safeguard the future of highly skilled workers whose professional work benefits the State and citizens and so we have to defend a collective interest too.

Gabriel also explained to the politicians our project: "the recognition of professional skills acquired by employees notary alongside the Notary".

Then we required to formalize - for the first time in Italy - the figure of "assistant notary" never officially recognized although present for decades, depositary of confidence, experience and professionalism and in perfect harmony for a team winning.

We want to let know everybody our work, what we do, our professionalism because in the future we will be able to choose and join all the oportunities that the work market wil give us.

It was an important historical moment for us "Italians employed notary".

Rossetti had also mentioned our **Confederation** (*CPNUE*) and the importance of cooperation and confrontation at European level.

It was a first step, but an important one, and we started to established a network of political contacts to advance our project and defend our future, without wanting to create a register in orden to replace the notaries but only to recognize and defend our professionalism and our future

This had to be stressed too.
